Allocation Criteria



1. Merit (Overall Performance + Relevant Subject Requirement)

- The first and most important criterion is a **student's academic performance**.
- Those who have done well academically and have proven to be able to meet the demands of their preferred subject combinations will be considered first.
- To be considered for a particular subject combination, student must meet the various pre-requisites first.

2. Student's Choice

- The school understands that each student has his/her individual interest. As long as the student qualifies for a particular subject combination, his or her choice will be taken into consideration.

Allocation Criteria



3. Teachers' Recommendations

- At times when vacancies for a particular subject combination is limited, the school will also consult Subject teachers for recommendations, for example learning attitude and aptitude.

4. School's Resources and Manpower

- The school will try our best to accommodate students' choices, but there are constraints on physical resources and teachers. The school is unable to offer a certain subject combination if the take-up rate is too low.

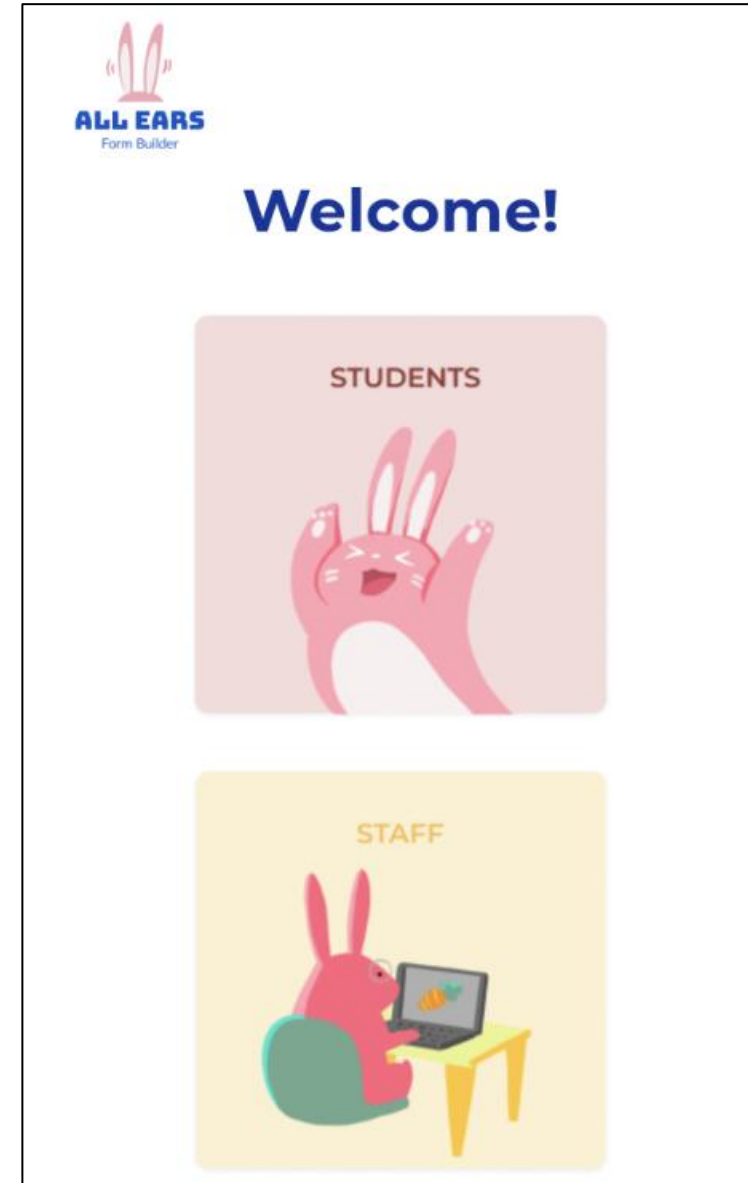


