Dear Parents/Guardians,

Welcome back to a new Semester!

We hope the recent break allowed for a restful and meaningful time of reconnection for you and your family. Semester 2 is set to be a cornerstone of the academic year—an exciting period filled with diverse learning opportunities designed to challenge and inspire our students to develop as Lifelong Learners, Future-Ready Leaders and Active Citizens. For both our Secondary 2 and graduating students, this is a pivotal season of transition. We look forward to working closely with you to ensure they are well-prepared, motivated, and empowered for the next chapters of their educational journey.

A. Semester 2 Calendar of Events

Our Semester 2 Calendar of Events is at Annex A for your reference. We seek your understanding should there be any changes during the Semester to our schedule of events. We also encourage you to have regular conversations with your child/ward about their involvement in various school programmes.

Some highlights for Semester 2 include:

1) Shine on 2 Programme (7 – 10 July 2026):

Our Shine on 2 Programme is a holistic programme to encourage our students to be Lifelong Learners, Future-Ready Leaders and Active Citizens and provides a host of exciting programmes for our Secondary 1 to 3 students which include a mix of outdoor activities such as the Secondary 1 Outdoor and Adventure Learning Camp, Secondary 2 Kayaking Enrichment and Secondary 3 Sports Carnival. Secondary 2 and 3 students will also have stretch programmes such as the Story Telling Public Speaking and Applied Learning Programme respectively.

2) National Day Celebrations (7 August 2026):

We will be organising a National Day Celebration and Carnival as part of the commemoration for SG61. In addition to the Recollections and Parade, there will be a carnival incorporating games and our signature Farmers' and Makers' Market (FMM). As we celebrate our nation's growth, we also want to take this opportunity to build a 'We First' society, where we aim to support everyone's growth in the community. Proceeds raised during FMM will be donated to Cerebral Palsy Alliance Singapore. We will be inviting parents on a sign-up basis to join us at this event, please look out for the Parents Gateway notification that will be sent to you.





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3) Talent Development Programmes (Ongoing):

A wide range of student development experiences in Semester 2 will deepen students' interests and passions. These include:

- Learning journeys and workshops under our Applied Learning Programme (ALP), Lifelong Learning Programme (LLP), and programmes in the arts and sciences
- Platforms for students to showcase talents such as Kaleidoscope and Sports Carnival

Selected students will also participate in our final two Overseas Educational Programmes (OEP) for the year:

- Champions OEP to Japan – 26 October 2026 to 31 October 2026
- Spotlight OEP to Seoul – 26 October 2026 to 31 October 2026

B. Reminders about School Rules and Regulations

At Loyang View, our core values of Integrity, Respect, Responsibility, Resilience, and Compassion serve as the compass for our students' daily interactions. As we prepare them for the complexities of the future, we remain committed to upholding high standards of conduct. This semester, we are placing a special emphasis on Respect. We invite parents to join us in reminding our students that their words and actions have a profound impact on those around them.

To foster this culture of mutual respect, we invite you to partner with us in a few key areas. Firstly, we encourage you to discuss the importance of respecting all members of our community, including school staff who work tirelessly to support their growth, and the care of common property which serves us all. Secondly, please engage your child in conversations about social media mindfulness, reminding them that respect extends into digital spaces where words can have a lasting impact. Finally, by role-modelling positive conflict resolution and empathy in daily life, we can collectively demonstrate to our students how respect translates into meaningful everyday choices. Together, we can ensure that every Loyang View student carries themselves with the grace and character necessary for their future success.

C. Supporting our Secondary Two Students

For our Secondary 2 students, Semester 2 marks a pivotal transition as they prepare for the Subject Combination Exercise. As their choice of subjects will form the foundation for their Upper Secondary experience, we encourage parents/guardians to have a discussion with your child about their interests, strengths, and aspirations to help facilitate decision making about their subject combinations for next year.

To support these discussions, we recommend directing your child's attention to available school resources and Education and Career Guidance (ECG) tools. It is also important to stay informed about the revised Singapore-Cambridge General Certification of Education (SEC), which replaces the previous O- and N-Level examinations. Understanding how this new certificate and the various post-secondary pathways (such as JC, Polytechnic, and ITE) align





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with your child's chosen subjects will empower them to make informed decisions. We look forward to working with you to help our students choose a path that best ignites their passion for learning. We will be having an online information session for parents of Secondary 2 students on 17 July 2026, with more details provided with Parents Gateway in due course.

D. Supporting our Graduating Students

Our graduating students are entering a defining phase of their journey as they prepare for the National Examinations. This begins with the Listening Comprehension and Oral Examinations in Term 3, culminating in the written papers in Term 4. At this stage, we encourage our students to take full ownership of their learning by staying disciplined with their revision schedules and maintaining punctuality for all assessments. Success in these examinations is a result of consistent effort and a proactive mindset. To rigorously prepare our students, the school will be conducting timed practices from 7 to 10 July. This dedicated week will simulate examination conditions, helping students master their pacing and build the mental stamina required for the national papers.

To support this, we invite parents to partner with us in creating a conducive home environment that is free from distractions, allowing your child to focus and recharge effectively. Beyond the home, we strongly encourage students to utilise the dedicated study spaces in school, such as the library, which provide a quiet and productive atmosphere for revision.

Furthermore, we hope to see our students take the initiative to attend school intervention programmes and be proactive in seeking consultations with their teachers to clarify doubts. As a school, we will continue to provide academic support through study club sessions and Education and Career Guidance (ECG). Whether your child is exploring the Early Admission Exercise (EAE) or Direct School Admissions (DSA), having open conversations at home about post-secondary pathways is crucial. We encourage you to explore the websites of various Junior Colleges, Polytechnics, and ITEs together to help them make informed and inspired choices for their future.
