A. Term 2 Calendar of Events

Our Term 2 Calendar of Events can be found in Annex A for your reference. We aim to provide timely information to help you take note of important dates and events. Some highlights include:

- **Cross Country Run:**
Our annual cross country will be held on Thursday, 30 April, at Pasir Ris Park. This event aims to promote a healthy lifestyle and allows students to come together to support one another, build resilience, and develop sportsmanship. We are excited to have parents join us to run alongside your child and look forward to seeing you there.
- **Mother Tongue Languages Fortnight:**
This two-week programme will be held from 30 March to 10 April. It aims to strengthen students' cultural understanding and enhance their Mother Tongue Language competency through structured activities and workshops. Each level will engage in distinct thematic activities, ranging from traditional culinary arts to heritage games, aligned with their learning objectives.
- **MOE-Outward Bound School (OBS) Challenge**
The MOE-OBS challenge, held from 13 April to 17 April, is an outdoor education programme for all Secondary 3 students, designed to develop resilience, teamwork, and leadership skills through experiential learning in outdoor environments. During this multi-day residential programme, students will participate in various outdoor activities that challenge them both physically and mentally whilst fostering personal growth and confidence.

- **Overseas Educational Programme (OEP)**

We are launching our OEP for the year with trips for selected students in various talent development programmes. In Term 2, selected Sec 2 students will have the opportunity to participate in our OEP to Selangor, Malaysia, which focuses on developing global awareness and cross-cultural competencies; and selected Sec 3 students in our Futurist Programme will embark on our OEP to China. Both programmes are designed to broaden students' horizons, deepen their global awareness, and foster growth in their respective areas of interest and expertise.

- B. **Personal Learning Device (PLD) Rollout for Secondary 1 students**

Our Secondary 1 students will receive their Personal Learning Devices (PLD) on Thursday, 26 March. Students will report to their classrooms at 2.30 p.m. to undergo the onboarding process with staff and vendors.

Parents can choose the desired setting for their child's/ward's PLD via the Device Management Application (DMA). The DMA supports students as they learn to use their PLD safely and responsibly. More information will be sent to parents nearer the date.

- C. **School Rules and Regulations:**

Loyang View students are to exhibit our school values of Integrity, Respect, Responsibility, Resilience, and Compassion in their words and actions. We hold them to high standards to prepare them for the future.

Mobile phone usage

We have implemented a new rule this year prohibiting mobile phone use during school hours, including recess, lunch, and CCAs. By and large, students have adjusted well to this change, and we have observed them spending more time chatting and interacting with their peers, supporting one another with learning during revision periods, and playing sports and games during recess and lunch. Punctuality and Attendance

Punctuality for school reflects our students' sense of responsibility. While we have adjusted our school start times to encourage adequate sleep, we have observed that late-coming remains an issue for some students. As traffic conditions worsen later in the morning, we encourage students to leave home early enough to arrive on time. Students who are not present during attendance-taking at 7.50 a.m. on Mondays to Fridays will be considered late for school.
